SMACNA PROJECT MANAGERS INSTITUTE

In 2012 we held SMACNA's Project Managers Institute. All those in attendance and the firms they were employed by gave the course a glowing report and advised they would have additional people attend the course when it is presented again. With this in mind we are contemplating holding this valuable program at the Ontario Sheet Metal Workers Training Center in late October or early November **if** significant interest is expressed by our contractors.

We would require a minimum of fifteen participants with a maximum of twenty.

The attached sheets provide the Program Description, Target Audience and Instructors as well as giving insight into the programs time lines.

This program is traditionally provided by SMACNA in the southern portion of the United States and with a course cost of \$2,200 plus dinners, hotel accommodations and air travel costs. This cost of attendance may be prohibitive.

The anticipated cost for holding the program at our centre would be **\$1,950 per attendee**. The cost includes breakfast and lunch each day. For those requiring overnight accommodations we can tie into the preferred rates negotiated at local hotels by our Training Centre for in-school apprentices.

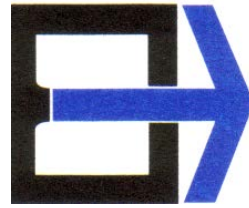
